## **New High School**

- February 15th construction equipment is set to appear, weather pending
- Completion in 2021 (doors opening in fall of 2021)
- Comments on some concerns within the community about entrances and exits
- Talk about drop off/pick up traffic on the roads

## **New Elementary**

- Set to open in fall of 2020
- New Demographic Study
  - Now tenth largest district in MO most likely soon to be ninth
  - MGT Consulting Group working to help guide 2019 Boundary Committee
- New Boundaries
  - MGT to help through this process
  - April to May 2019 Demographic study completed and committee formed
  - May to November Boundary committee to work and formulate boundaries
  - December 2019 New boundaries presented to the BOE for approval

- Want the students and buildings to adjust for a semester (Spring 2020)
- Boundary changes will most likely impact all schools
- o Talking about positives and negatives of the last boundary shift
- Do have space on the new high school's campus for a new middle school someday
- Questions about the Boundary committee and how it all works (what is taken into consideration, old boundary shifts, etc)
- CSIP Update
  - November and January GPS Meetings were held next GPS Meeting is on Tuesday February 12th
  - About 75 people attended and 50 watched live on Facebook
  - November Teaching and Learning
    - Chromebooks/technology are having a positive impact however there is a struggle with the amount available at elementary level
    - Access versus ownership (elementary school level kids do not really need the technology at a 1:1 ratio)
    - Concerns about parent access of online textbooks parents not being able to have access and therefore not being able to help their students
  - January Finances, Facilities and Staffing
    - Tax increase support 85.2% would support operating cost tax increase
    - Discussion on class sizes (hiring more teaching to lower class sizes) versus first year hire pay rate - which is more of a priority? We do not have the space (at the moment) to get K-6 class sizes to DESE desirable standard.
- Marketing/Logo Update
  - Just approved 17th marketing partner
  - District logo has not been updated in over 10 years
- Inclement Weather
  - Discussion on last early release BOE met and it is understood now that the district will shut down next time, applies to everyone
- Updated Academic Calendar
  - Last day (as it stands right now) is May 31st, 2019

 Summer school is still being worked out at the moment - need July for preparation for the next school year

Substitute teaching is a problem in the buildings. Discussion on application process and that everyone in the area is struggling.

BOE members not being allowed into the schools. Conversation about Board commitments happening.
