*In accordance with Section 170.045 RSMo., school districts are required to provide age and developmentally appropriate sexual abuse prevention education to students. Under Missouri Law, this education will include the following components, at a minimum:

- 1. Instruction providing students with the knowledge and tools to recognize sexual abuse,
- 2. Instruction providing students with the knowledge and tools to report an incident of sexual abuse,
- 3. Actions that a student who is a victim of sexual abuse could take to obtain assistance and intervention, and
- 4. Available resources for students affected by sexual abuse.

**Pursuant to Section 170.048 RSMo., school districts are required to have in place a policy that addresses and includes, but is not limited to, the following:

- 1. Strategies that can help identify students who are at possible risk of suicide;
- 2. Strategies and protocols for helping students at possible risk of suicide; and
- 3. Protocols for responding to a suicide death.

The Wentzville School District addresses this state statute through Policy 2785.

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
