





Contractor Hired for New Elementary School

The Board approved hiring Lawlor Corporation to construct the new elementary school on Interstate Drive in Wentzville. Executive Director of Facilities John Blanton shared with the Board that there were seven bids received for the project that ranged from a low bid of \$23,705,000 to a high bid of \$26,850,009, and that Lawlor was the low bid and recommendation for the project. He also shared that Lawlor most recently constructed Stone Creek Elementary and has also done additions at Boone Trail, South Middle and Frontier Middle School.
