

Board Meeting Report

May 21, 2020 Board Meeting held Virtually



This month's Board of Education meeting was held virtually to comply with the Governor's order and guidance from our local health officials. Open Session was live-streamed via the District's YouTube channel and you can view the recording by visiting the WSD on YouTube.

**The Board approved the retirement of Ms. Rebekkah Montes**. Ms. Montes has worked for the District for 13 years as an assistant principal at Frontier Middle School.

The Board accepted the resignation of Mr. Hasan Nasufovic, Director of Custodial Services, effective June 15, 2020.

The Board approved creating new positions for three girls head wrestling coaches (one at each high school) and six assistant golf coaches (two at each high school to work with both boys and girls teams).

The Board approved creating 47.5 new certified positions, including a reading interventionist at each elementary school, 12 new support staff positions, and three new administrative positions, contingent on the passing of Proposition S on June 2.


With the approval of the administrative salary schedule and support staff pay (not covered under a union), the Board has now approved salaries for all groups with a contingency for both if Prop S passes and if the proposition fails on June 2.

## 2020-2021 Reentry Task Force

**Reentry Task Force...** Superintendent Dr. Curtis Cain shared <u>a presentation about</u> the Reentry Task Force which outlines the structure and process developed to follow and formulate plans to open school in the fall. He stressed that there would be multiple scenarios and contingency plans as the pandemic continues to be a fluid situation and guidance from health officials will likely change as well. He also shared that the goal is to have plans in place to share by mid-to-late July.

**ACADEMIC CALENDAR REVISION**... The Board approved revisions to the <u>2020-2021 Academic Calendar</u> based on negotiations with the NEA and closure of schools due to COVID-19. The revisions include:

- 1. Reduction of late starts by six (6).
- 2. March 19, 2021- No school to accommodate THS hosting the State Student Council Convention. This event was canceled during the 2019-20 school year due to COVID-19.
- 3. April 2, 2021- School will be in session. This attendance day replaces the March 19, 2021 attendance day.
- 4. Added language to explain calendar dates are subject to change. Six emergency makeup days have been built into the calendar. Any additional days will extend the school year. This means that June 3, 2021 will be the last day of school unless the District is closed for more than six inclement weather days.
