Roadmap to Reopening Plan... Dr. Cain and members of Cabinet <u>presented an overview of the plan to return to school</u> and answered multiple questions from the Board related to the plan. Following the discussion, the Board approved the District's <u>Roadmap to Reopening Plan</u> for the 2020-2021 school year. "We understand and

appreciate that each of you have unique and personal situations that may be causing you concern during this pandemic," said Dr. Cain. "Which is why we are pleased to offer you a choice as to what is best for your child(ren) and your family." Parents have two options to choose from for the new school year: in-person learning with phases that will change depending on the health conditions in the community and in our schools, or 100% virtual learning. *Parents are asked to make that choice for their student by July 28 so that we may plan accordingly.* Additional details about the plan can be found on the <u>WSD website</u>.

Dr. Cain shared at the beginning of the meeting that he regretted that he could not be there in person and explained that he learned on Friday that he had been in contact to someone who tested positive for COVID-19. He also shared that his own test had come back negative and that he was self quarantined as a precaution.
