

Important Summer Dates and Information

WMS students and families,

We hope your summer has been going well, and everyone has had a chance to enjoy the sunshine, relax and spend time with families and friends. WMS is gearing up for an exciting time in school history! We have a lot of outstanding staff and students returning to our building, as well as a lot of new staff and new students joining us this year. We are excited about the changes we have coming our way, and look forward to having a great year at WMS. Please see below for some important information and upcoming dates.



On **Friday, August 5**, the parent and student portal will open and schedules and teacher assignments will be available to view. Please understand that due to tight scheduling and careful planning to balance out each grade level team, we cannot change a student's team. Each grade level will have lunch together and students could potentially have PE or an elective with students on other teams in their grade level.

Also on this day, the online registration will open for existing families. All families are asked to complete this step which includes updating contact information, acknowledging discipline policies, and accepting the responsible use policy, prior to the first day of school so that students have online access to their Chromebook. If this information is not completed in the parent portal, your student will lose online access on **August 17** until it is completed. Before school starts, team teachers will be reaching out to families to share the additional items that they would like to add to the universal 6th-8th grade supply list that is included in the additional \$10 of supplies. Please see below for the supply list document.

Transportation information will be emailed to families on **Friday, August 12**. Any concerns with transportation, stops, bus routes, etc., should be directed to the transportation department.

The District will host a Back to School Fair on **Saturday, August 13**, at Liberty High School from 8-11am. Families can pick up free school supplies and meet with various community resources. The district will no longer be providing free breakfast and lunch to all students. If your family could benefit from the Free & Reduced meal program, fill out the document below and return it to the main office.

Our **sixth-grade students** will be invited to attend our Where Everybody Belongs (WEB) orientation day on **Monday**, **August 15**. This event will be led by our 8th-grade WEB Leaders and is a <u>student-only</u> event. Students need to be dropped off by 8am and picked up at 12pm. No RSVP needed, just send your 6th grader and water bottle if desired. We look forward to meeting them!

Later that same day, **Monday, August 15, from 3-6pm**, families will be invited to WMS to attend our Walk-About-Day. At this event, you will be able to tour the building to find classes, pick up Chromebooks (6th/7th grade), learn more about WMS, order spirit wear, and sign up for the WMS PTA. Lulu's Shaved Ice will also be there.
