Position Title: Transportation Safety and Training Coordinator

### SUMMARY

Provides and maintains the highest quality trained drivers and aides to transport students in a safe and timely manner. Works cooperatively with the Director of Transportation, Operation Managers, Trainers and Dispatchers in maintaining a professional and positive work environment.

# QUALIFICATION/REQUIREMENTS

Minimum of high school diploma or general education degree required. The Transportation Safety and Training Coordinator shall have a minimum of five (5) years of experience, preferably in the student transportation industry, and must possess a valid CDL license with Passenger & School Bus Endorsements. Must possess or have the ability to obtain valid Missouri School Bus Driver Instructor Certification.

### **ESSENTIAL JOB DUTIES**

- Instructs drivers and aides on State and Federal rules and regulations, District Policies and Transportation/Union Agreements and Handbooks.
- Conducts classroom and on route training for new and experienced drivers and aides.
- Organizes and implements training for drivers and aides prior to the start of each school year.
- Performs bi-annual CDL license checks with the Dept. of Revenue in September and March of each year.
- Maintains training records for all drivers and aides.
- Reviews, revises and implements the highest quality of a continual training program for drivers and aides.
- Be available as a mentor and resource for drivers and aides.
- Reviews bus videos and provides constructive input as needed.
- Leads the investigation of accidents and safety concerns at bus stops.
- Generates accident reports and maintains accident files and database.
- Leads the development and presentation of monthly safety meetings.
- Leads and monitors the annual mobility testing of department staff.
- Leads the development and presentation of an annual school bus safety program at elementary schools.
- Attends meetings in accordance with departmental requirements.
- Fills in as a substitute driver as necessary.
- Acquaints substitute drivers to all aspects of bus routes.

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- Accompanies drivers and aides for training and observation purposes.
- Trains drivers concerning all aspects of the CDL test.
- Supervises other department trainers.
- Observes student loading and unloading procedures.
- Observes drivers and aides passenger management procedures.
- Immediately reports bus safety or hazardous conditions to the Director of Transportation.
- Coordinates Emergency Evacuation procedures for buses at least two times each year.
- Maintains bus first aid kits, body fluid kits and other driver's supplies.
- Maintains flexible work hours.

#### OTHER DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Promotes safety practices for all Transportation employees. Performs other related duties as assigned by the Director of Transportation.
