SUMMARY

Assists the Teaching & Learning and Student Services departments in the development, implementation, and evaluation of a district intervention program and provides data resources related to intervention.

QUALIFICATIONS/REQUIREMENTS

The District Intervention Coach shall have completed the equivalent of at least a Bachelor's Degree in Education. Classroom teaching experience is required with a valid Missouri teaching certificate. Experience or training in the CI3T Model of Prevention or a similar model of multi-tiered and integrated intervention supports preferred.

- Creates districtwide structures for tiered interventions.
- Assists with the implementation of intervention services.
- Provides training in the area of intervention identification, creation, and instruction.
- Assists schools with the development of an intervention process.
- Researches best practices in the area of intervention services and supports.
- Supports the application of classroom interventions.
- Actively participates in district and community programs.
- Demonstrates effective administrative, communication, organizational, problem-solving, and decision-making skills.
- Builds and maintains positive, professional relationships with district personnel, parents, and the community.
- Models a sense of professional responsibility through networking with other districts and professional organizations and participating in professional growth activities.
